Visits of two Monasteries. We start our return trip towards Athens, with a short stop at **Thermopylae** (Leonidas statue). Dinner and Overnight in Athens

Athens - Argolis - Delphi

5 days stay in Athens. Full day tour to Argolis and Delphi. 5D / 4N

Athens is the historical capital of Greece, with a long history, dating from the first settlement in the Neolithic age. In the 5th Century BC (the “Golden Age of Pericles”) – the culmination of Athens’ long, fascinating history – the city’s values and civilization acquired a universal significance. Over the years, a multitude of conquerors occupied Athens, and erected unique, splendid monuments - a rare historical palimpsest. In 1834, it became the capital of the modern Greek state and in two centuries since it has become an attractive modern metropolis with unrivalled charm.

> DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT ATHENS

Arrival in Athens. Our Staff will meet the group in the Arrivals Hall and will escort them to the waiting Bus. Transfer to the Hotel and check-in. Free time for lunch and a walk in the city. Dinner and Overnight in Athens.

> DAY 2 | FULL DAY DELPHI.

Breakfast at the hotel. Drive via the Boeotia plains towards Delphi “The Center of the World”. Visit of the **Archaeological Museum** and the **Apollo Sanctuary** at the archaeological site. Lunch at a local Restaurant in Delphi. On the way back to Athens we will visit 11th C monastery of **Osios Lukas**, situated in a picturesque valley teemed with olive trees. Byzantine monasteries are built in sites characterized by amazing natural beauty, always in harmony with the surrounding landscape, following the example of the ancient temples. Dinner and Overnight in Athens.

> DAY 3 | FULL DAY ARGOLIS.

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we drive towards Peloponnese. First stop will be in **Corinth Channel** for photos. Continue to **Mycenae** and visit the Palace and the Museum. Athens - Peloponnese

Full day in Athens. Visits to Corinth Canal, Mycenae, Epidaurus, Nafplion, Monemvasia, Sparta, Messini, Olympia 8D / 7N

The Peloponnese, located on the southern part of the country, is the most popular region of the Greek mainland with the most undiscovered beauties. Geographically the Peloponnese has the shape of a plane tree leaf, hosts the most important archaeological sites of Greece, has picturesque seaside places, gorgeous beaches, castles and Ski centres. Peloponnese is an all year-round destination and with our 08 day tour program of the Peloponnese you get to see the highlights.

> DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT ATHENS Arrival at the Athens airport – transfer to the hotel by Luxury bus. Dinner and Overnight.

> DAY 2 | ATHENS FULL DAY CITY TOUR.

The striking contrast between breath-taking monuments of a glorious past and modern elegant structures, is what you will enjoy during your tour of Athens. Visit the **Acropolis**, the crowning beauty and glory of Ancient Athens. Drive to the **Roman Temple of Olympic Zeus**, the **Panathenaic Stadium** (site of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896), the **Tomb of the unknown Soldier** in front of the **Parliament House** on Constitution Square. See views of government buildings and elegant structures of the 19th century. Drive along **Panepistimiou Avenue** and view the **Academy, University, National Library**. In contrast, conclude your tour with a visit to the new Acropolis museum, a marvel of architecture with a full exhibition of the glory of Ancient Athens. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

> DAY 3 | ATHENS - MYCENAE - EPIDAUROS - NAFPLION - TOLO.

Depart from Athens to Nafplion, first capital of Greece. Visit the **Corinth Canal**. Visit and private guided tour of the **Mycenae** archaeological site, tomb of Agamemnon and archaeological museum. Drive to **Epidaurus**, where you will have a private guided tour of the famous Amphitheatre and site. Drive back to **Nafplion** visit of the Palamidi Castle – dinner and overnight in **Tolo**.

> DAY 4 | NAFPLIO - SPARTA - MYSTRAS.

We leave Nafplion in the morning. We'll drive south by the scenic coast of the Argolis Gulf. From Astros we will turn to Central Peloponnese, (Arcadia), through the village of **Agios Petros** (short stop) and then off to Karies on the slopes of the mount Parnon. Shortly we will arrive in **Sparti**, the modern town was developed in the reign of King Otto after 1834. We will visit the archaeological site, the Acropolis and the theatre of Ancient Sparta and then on to visit the **Medieval state of Mystras**, once the second most important town of the Byzantine Empire. Dinner and overnight in Mystras or Sparti.

> DAY 5 | MONEMVASIA - MANI - KALAMATA.

Leave Sparti behind us for **Monemvasia**, which is built on an island rock attached by a causeway to the mainland. On the way we will visit **Githeo**, a seaside town. Then drive on to **Areopolis** a large village, with taverns, in the typical Maniot style, tower houses and churches. We will visit **Vathia** forsaken by almost all its inhabitants, Vathia and Kita are the most impressive tower communities which are characteristic of Mani. Dinner and overnight in **Kalamata**.

> DAY 6 | KALAMATA - ANCIENT MESSINI - OLYMPIA.

We leave for **Olympia** driving along the coast of the Ionian Sea. On the way we will visit the **ancient Messini**, one of the nicest and biggest archaeological sites in Greece. Arrive late afternoon in Olympia. Dinner and overnight in Olympia.

> DAY 7 | OLYMPIA - ATHENS.

Visit the ruins of Olympia the Sanctuary of the **Olympian Zeus** and the Museum. This is the largest archaeological site of Greece. There you will see for yourself the grandeur of the ancient sanctuary which through the Olympic Games was a symbol of Greek unity the cradle of the Olympic Games. Later in the afternoon we depart for Athens. Overnight in Athens.

> DAY 8 | ATHENS. After Breakfast - Transfer to the airport for the flight back home.

Athens - Ancient Messini - Kalamata

Ancient Messini is a rare archaeological site, where the visitor is impressed by viewing temples, houses and public. 5D / 4N

Kalamata, famous worldwide for its olives, is Messinia's capital and the second-largest city in the Peloponnese. Following independence from the Turks and thanks to the exploitation of the fertile Messinian lands (producing olive oil, raisins, figs etc), it developed into a wealthy urban centre and a significant port.

Ancient Messini is a rare archaeological site, where the visitor is impressed by viewing temples, houses, walls and public buildings, preserved in both high altitude and good condition.

> DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT ATHENS

Arrival at Athens Airport. Our Staff will meet you and will escort you to the waiting Bus for the transfer to your Hotel. For tonight we propose an optional Dinner at a traditional Greek Tavern with Music. Overnight.

> DAY 2 | ATHENS TO KALAMATA

The natural beauty of Messinia with the indented shores, sandy beaches, forested mountains and fertile valleys, coexists with significant archaeological monuments. Kalamata, the capital and central port of Messinia, is situated at the site of ancient Farai. The point of reference par excellence in the city of Kalamata is the legendary "castle of Isabeau" where the renowned International Dance Festival takes place annually. No less beautiful is the exquisite Palia Poli (Old City) at the foot of the Castle. The area is the hotspot for the city's youth, for it is the beating heart of the nightlife in Kalamata and by no means will it be still! Overnight in Kalamata.

> DAY 3 | ANCIENT MESSINI

Ancient Messini is one of the most important excavated cities of Greece. The ancient city is well preserved due to the fact that it was never destroyed or covered by a newer settlement. Picturesquely situated on a hillside below the village of Mavromati and still undergoing excavation, the site comprises a large theatre, an agora (marketplace), a sizeable Sanctuary of Asclepius and one of the most impressive Ancient Greek stadiums. The layout of Ancient Messini was made according to the so-called Hippodamian system, where all buildings have the same orientation and the space is divided into horizontal and vertical axes.

The Theatre of Messini is the first monument that the visitor meets in the archaeological site.

Between Theatre and Agora of Ancient Messini, they discovered the Fountain of Arsinoe who the daughter of the legendary king of Messinia was, Leucippus, and mother of Asclepius. To the east of the fountain there are the market boundaries of Ancient Messini, a huge square surrounded by Stoas. Asclepieion was the most famous place of Ancient Messini area as center of public life in the city along with the market. There are more than 140 pedestals of bronze statues of mostly political persons and five platforms surrounded the Doric temple, whose foundations dominate in the center of Asclepieion.

Stadium and Gymnasium are among the most impressive building blocks because of their good condition.

Overnight in Kalamata.

> DAY 4 | KALAMATA TO ATHENS

After breakfast we start our journey back to Athens. Overnight in Athens.

> DAY 5 | DEPARTURE

According to your flight schedule transfer to the Airport for the departure flight.





Athens - Crete

Athens - Heraklion - Rethymnon - Sfakia - Chania. 8D / 7N

In this island-continent, the largest of the Greek world, the refined civilization that enlightened Greece and its islands was born and flourished, as evidenced by the site of Knossos. The Cretan landscape offers a variety with its rugged mountains, deep gorges, peaceful bays and fertile lands, astonished, surprised and delighted.

> DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT ATHENS

Arrival at Athens Airport - transfer to the hotel - accommodation in Athens and overnight at the hotel.

> DAY 2 | ATHENS FULL DAY CITY TOUR.

Visit the site of **Acropolis** and take a panoramic tour of the area by bus. You will discover the center of the city, **Constitution Square** (Syntagma), the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**, the **Parliament** and neoclassical buildings in Avenue Venizelos (the Academy, the University and the National Library). On the way to the Acropolis you will see the **Hadrian's Arch**, the **Temple of Olympian Zeus**, and then you will see the **Panathenaic Stadium** where the first Olympic Games of our time were held in 1896 (short stop).

In the Acropolis you can admire the masterpieces of the golden era of Athens, the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike and finally "the harmony between spirit and matter", the Parthenon. Then you will visit the impressive sculptures, which adorned the temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion (with the Caryatids).

Back to hotel - Free afternoon – Transfer to the port for of Pireaus to take the Ferry to **Heraklion**.

> DAY 3 | ARRIVAL IN HERAKLION.

Arrive and transfer to the hotel. Heraklion Guided tour visit the **Minoan antiquities museum**, one of the most important in Greece, a necessary step to understand archaeological sites on the island. The museum holds the Snake Goddess and the Phaistos Disc, famous statuettes discovered at Knossos. Visit the arhaeolgal site of the **Palace of Knossos**, the most important site of the Minoan civilization.

Back to Heraklion. Dinner and overnight in Heraklion.

> DAY 4 | HERAKLION - SPINALOGA - AGIOS NIKOLAOS.

Breakfast and departure for **Spinalonga** Island. Depart for **Elounda** and board for a crossing in the **Gulf of Mirabello** to the island of **Spinalonga**. Return to **Agios Nikolaos** (short stop). You can visit a garden with Cretan therapeutic plants and flowers. Dinner and overnight in Heraklion.

> DAY 5 | RETHYMNON - CHANIA.

After breakfast, depart with our luggage for the city of **Chania**. On the way, stop in **Rethymnon**. City tour. Lunch in the old harbour. Visit the fortress guarding the old harbour and the minarets dating from the Turkish occupation of the island. Accommodation in Chania.

> DAY 6 | CHANIA - SFAKIA.

After breakfast, depart for **Sfakia**. There you can admire the views of the Libyan Sea. We will taste the pita in Sfakia and we drink our coffee on site. In the evening we offer a nice walk in the old town of Chania. Lunch during visits. Dinner and overnight in the vicinity of Chania.

> DAY 7 | CHANIA CITY TOUR.

Breakfast at the hotel. Chania, visits (Archaeological Museum, Venetian harbour and old town). Lunch during visits. Dinner lunch box. Boarding for Piraeus four berths in cabins with bathroom.

DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT "MAKEDONIA" AIRPORT - THESSALONIKI

The largest city of Northern Greece. Transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. An optional general tour of city can be offered in the late afternoon. Dinner (optional) and overnight at the hotel.

> DAY 2 | CITY TOUR THESSALONIKI

After breakfast an experienced guide will guide you to a panoramic tour of the city of Thessaloniki with luxury buses of our company. We will visit the **Arch, Byzantine churches, Rotonda, Saint Sofia, Egnatia, Aristotle Square.** Our bus will ascend the **Castle** over city where another world with end-less beauty unfolds. DAY 1 | ARRIVAL AT LARNACA AIRPORT. Our Students will be welcomed and greeted by our guide at Larnaca airport. During the transfer by a/c coach, our guide will outline the program, making suggestions for free time and offering general information on Cyprus. An advance registration will be arranged, so there will be no need for the students to queue to check in. After a welcome drink, (juice) our students will have some time to relax and enjoy the hotel's facilities. Dinner will be served at the hotel (on half board terms). Overnight at the hotel.

> DAY 2 | PAPHOS DELIGHTS. Breakfast at the hotel and depart for a full day tour to Paphos. Legend has it that Paphos was home of Aphrodite, goddess of beauty and love. Still under the spell of the goddess, the area retains her magic and has remained intact by time. Paphos itself is a leading cultural centre of the Mediterranean and the whole town is on the UNESCO World Heritage list. Passing through the **Fassouri** citrus plantations; we come across the medieval 13th century **Castle of Kolossi**. We continue to the ancient Kingdom of **Kourion**. Our next visit will be to the **Tombs of the Kings**, an early Hellenistic monument dating from the 4th century BC. Overnight at Larnaca.

> DAY 3 | FULL DAY NICOSIA, THE MEDIEVAL CAPITAL. Breakfast at the hotel and depart for a full day tour of Nicosia. Nicosia, or Lefkosia, lies roughly at the centre of the island, with a rich history that can be traced back to the Bronze Age. The heart of the city, enclosed by the 16th century Venetian walls, is dotted with museums, ancient churches and medieval buildings. The famous **Famagusta Gate** still stands proudly today. From

there, we will drive to the cathedral of St. John the Evangelist and its 13th and 18th century wall paintings. Enjoy a visit to the prominent Archaeological museum with its collection of Cypriot antiquities and treasures from the Neolithic age to the Early Byzantine period. After we arrive at **Laiki Geitonia** and stroll at leisure down its stone paved streets where lunch will be served. Students will explore the Byzantine museum in the afternoon.

In the late afternoon, we will return to the hotel in Limassol. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

> DAY 4 | FULL DAY TROODOS MOUNTAIN AND UNESCO CHURCHES. Breakfast at the hotel and depart for a full day tour of **Troodos Mountains**. **Kykkos** is the richest and most significant monastery on the island. Founded in 1100 and dedicated to the Virgin Mary, it possesses one of the three surviving icons ascribed to St. Luke. We will take a short stroll to Throni, to visit the tomb of the late Archbishop Makarios III. Lunch is served at a local tavern.

Our expedition will take us to Omodos, a traditional Cypriot wine producing village. Students can stroll around the village's winding streets and mingle with the locals.

In the late afternoon, we will return to the hotel in Limassol. Dinner and overnight at the hotel at Limassol.

> DAY 5 | DEPARTURE Our students will enjoy their breakfast at leisure. Check-out from the hotel and transfer by a/c coach to Larnaca Airport for their departure.
